A clergyman named Dodd was sentenced to hang for a loan scam. The sentence seemed unjust to many, including Samuel Johnson. He wrote an appeal to the court in Dodd's name. Many suspected the appeal came from someone else

(some suspected Johnson). Johnson's biographer asked about it, and Johnson denied it, saying, "Depend upon it, Sir, when a man knows he is to be hanged in a fortnight, it concentrates his mind wonderfully."3 2. Here the mind concentrates on God's word and God's ways

D. The joy of the word (14, 16) 1. Two words for joy

a. Not because he is about to hang

b. But because he is redeemed

b. In v. 16, the settled joy of one sitting at peace at home 2. This joy is in the believer's heart

a. In v. 14, the joy of festival and exultation

"This is not merely the scholar's pleasure ... but a disciple's, whose joy is in obedience."4 **Conclusion:**
